THE VISION

What was revealed was a tent meeting conducted at Franklin Field (Harambee Park) along Blue Hills Ave. The tent was white and it glowed with radiance. This vision is to be carried out especially by the Young Adults and the Youths of the church. It was shown that the youth and young adults are now professionals in their various fields of work and are skilled and equipped to carry forward the work that is to be done. The successfulness of this new adventure is dependent on the fervent prayer life of all that would be involved. We were encouraged to be **consistently in prayer for a year starting Saturday, August 1st 2015**

1. For the work to be done, a Christ-like spirit,
2. A willingness to serve and
3. The power to tell the world Jesus is coming soon



This work would be done by voluntary effort on the part of all who would be involved and the attendance would be free for all who would attend. The challenge is for all to sacrifice or contribute a \$1 a day for 365 days to be given and collected from the young adults, youths and teenagers who would be taught to sacrifice for the work of the Lord. The \$1 a day is a reminder that my people are required to **pray fervently for themselves and the success of the meetings**. The \$1 a day is because we have been entrusted with this financial means to fulfill this aspect.



- It was shown that during the day the tent was not to be vacant. Activities geared to the community, such as: Summer Kids Program, Games, Art and Craft, are some of the activities that would encourage the community to be apart of the meetings. T-shirts, various in colors are to be distributed for identification by groups for the day and one color, same for all, should be used for the night.
- The evening meetings were to be broadcast which would to reach a wider audience
- Also, the meetings should be free from anyone idle playing around the tent premises, or loud talking while the meetings are in progress. Everyone should be taught that God's presence is there and should be reverence because by their conduct others would know about the Lord.

- It was shown that work was to be carried by youth

- Preparation should begin a year in advance. **During the year, work should be done to inform, meet, garner interest, study, train and prepare the people for the meeting. Communities should be visited, friends, co-workers, all should be made aware and told of the meeting.** By this event the communities would know who God is, who the Adventists are and decide to be part of the community
- Before the start of the meetings a special prayer and anointing service should be done. The Ministers should anoint the volunteer workers and the place of meeting. The day after would be the enrollment day and the starting of the meetings. The closing of the meetings would comprise a banquet setting where new converts would receive the hand of fellowship and appreciation shown for all volunteer.

“My Sheep Knows My Voice” is the words of assurance to all. By telling or sharing the vision they would know it is not you but from the Lord. In sharing this vision, ask how has the Lord spoken to you about the work that is to be done? The greatest impact of this event would be what takes place throughout the day. This is what would lead others to know the Lord. The impact this event would have would cause a call for other workers to come and assist in carrying out the work to be done.

The success of this outreach depends on my people praying for a year. **Taking up the challenge to do this work is committing to praying for a year. This is all about what would be done through us by the power of the Holy Spirit.** By doing this, others would do likewise to reach their communities.
